## TASTER/WORKSHOP SESSIONS

We offer the following career focussed taster/workshop sessions:

### Art & Design

Pupils create a logo and produce a laser-cut key ring or sticky label.

### Child Care

Pupils plan a range of child-friendly tasks and learn more about caring for young children.

### Construction

This is a practical session in basic brickwork, painting & decorating, plastering and woodwork skills.

### Creative and Digital

**Games design:** An introduction to character design in the world of 2D animation.

**Media production:** Video editing and special effects workshop using the latest software.

**Music Tech./recording:** Hands on session in professional hi-tech recording studio.

### Enterprise/Entrepreneurs

Pupils take a business idea and work as a team to develop their business plan using marketing concepts and strategies.

### Fashion and Clothing

Pupils learn more about fashion trends and forecasting - to produce a fashion style; or how to use garments/accessories to style a fashion shoot.



### Hair and Beauty Therapies

Pupils learn the basics of hairdressing and styling techniques as well as basic beauty therapy skills.

### Health and Social Care

An insight is given into a variety of health and social care roles, as well as a variety of practical activities around health and wellbeing.

### ICT

Pupils visit the college's state of the art IT facilities and find out more about careers in the IT industry.

### Motor Vehicle

A hands-on skills session which takes place in the College's industry standard motor vehicle workshop.

### Science

Pupils take part in a series of fun experiments and find out more about careers and opportunities in the science industry.

### Sports and Public Services

Pupils gain skills in the use of exercise and fitness measuring apparatus, or have a chance to trial for the College's own football academy.

## Travel and Tourism

Pupils have a chance to role-play in a number of customer service settings. They also find out more about careers in the travel and tourism industry.
